This is an HSA Bargaining Unit Position and requires Union membership. This posting is open to female and male applicants.

Summary of Duties:

- Work with clients to provide case management, assessment, goal setting and treatment planning;
- Individual and group counselling;
- Maintain appropriate file documentation;
- Attend and participate in staff meetings, Care Team meetings, consultation, administration and related agency activities as requested;
- Provide prevention services.
- Required to work in a variety of settings with youth and their parents and/or caregivers.
