

Free Income Tax Clinic for Seniors

May 20th–July 30th, 2020

To Be Eligible, you must be:

- 65 years or older
- A resident of the Tri-Cities
- Living at Home

We are unable to help if you:

- Are self – employed or have employment expenses
- Have rental income
- Have interest income over \$1,000

What to Bring:

- Your Care Card or Picture ID
- Information Slips (T4, T4A, T5, T5007, T3 etc.)
- Receipts (Medical Expenses, Charitable donations, etc.)
- Previous year's notice of Assessment

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the service is provided using a drop off/pick up system. You can drop off your tax documents on **Tuesday or Thursday between 10:00 and 12:00**. You will be called before your tax return is submitted to CRA electronically, and when your tax documents will be ready for pick up from SHARE. Pick up is also on Tuesday or Thursday 10:00-12:00.
