## Early childhood development

Early years and family supports that strengthen healthy child development and parenting to build confident and connected families.

## Food security

A food bank that supports children, families and seniors to meet their food needs.

## Senior living

Aging in place and independent living services for seniors.

## Disability + accessibility

Services for children and youth with developmental disabilities.

## Housing + basic needs advocacy

Housing advocacy, rent bank assistance and tenancy and poverty law services to help prevent homelessness.

English language and settlement supports that help newcomers/refugees build skills, confidence and connection.

## Mental health + substance use

Lifespan care including play-based therapy for children, peer support and counselling for youth through our wellness centre Foundry Tri-Cities, individual/whole family counselling and addiction supports for adults.

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## **Residual giving**      **Provide a percentage of your estate.**

Suggested wording in your will: *I give to SHARE Family and Community Services Society, charitable number 11887 5798 RRO001, \_\_\_\_\_ percent (%) of the residue of my estate.*
